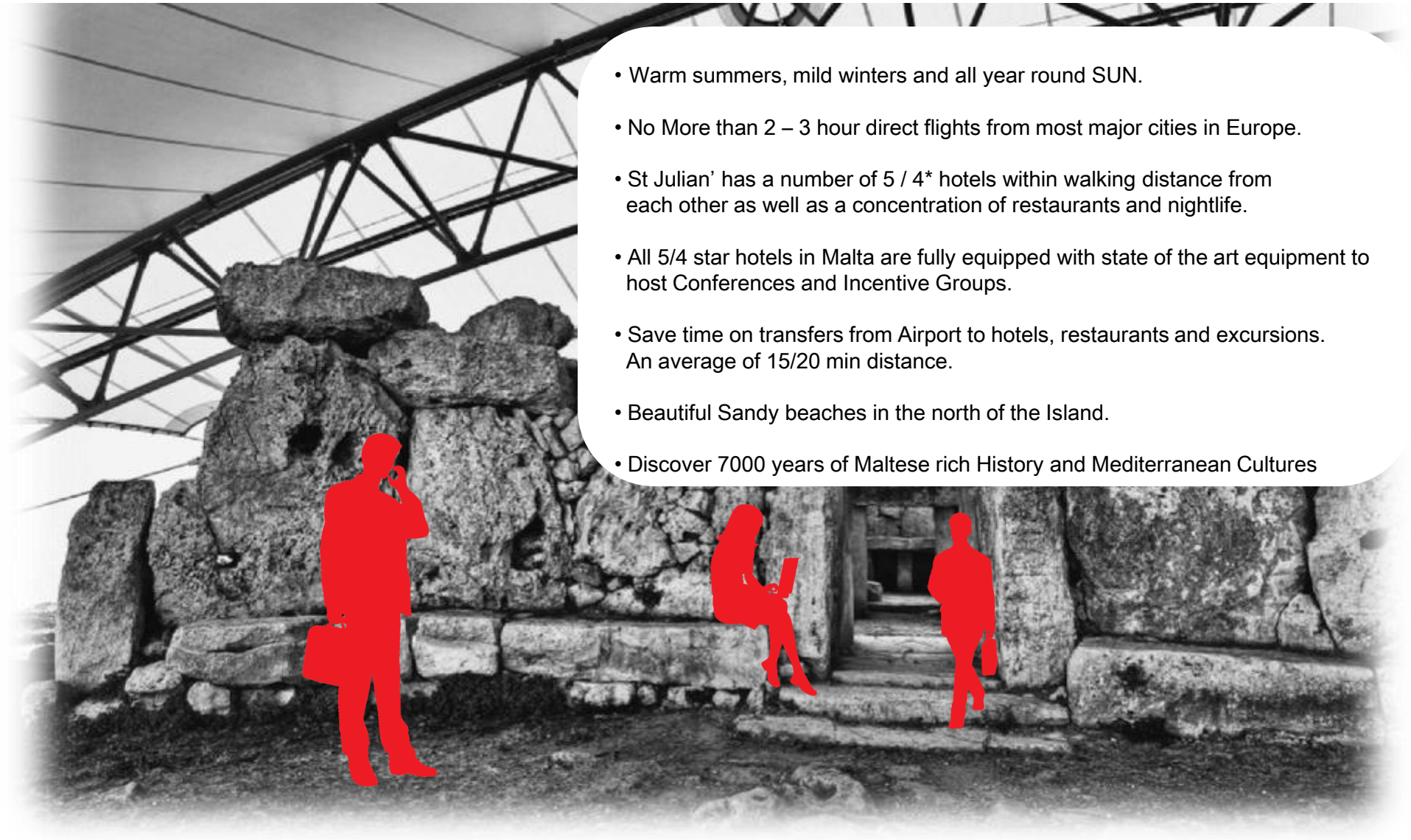






## Why BEA goes to Malta?

- Discover 7000 years of Maltese rich History and Mediterranean Cultures

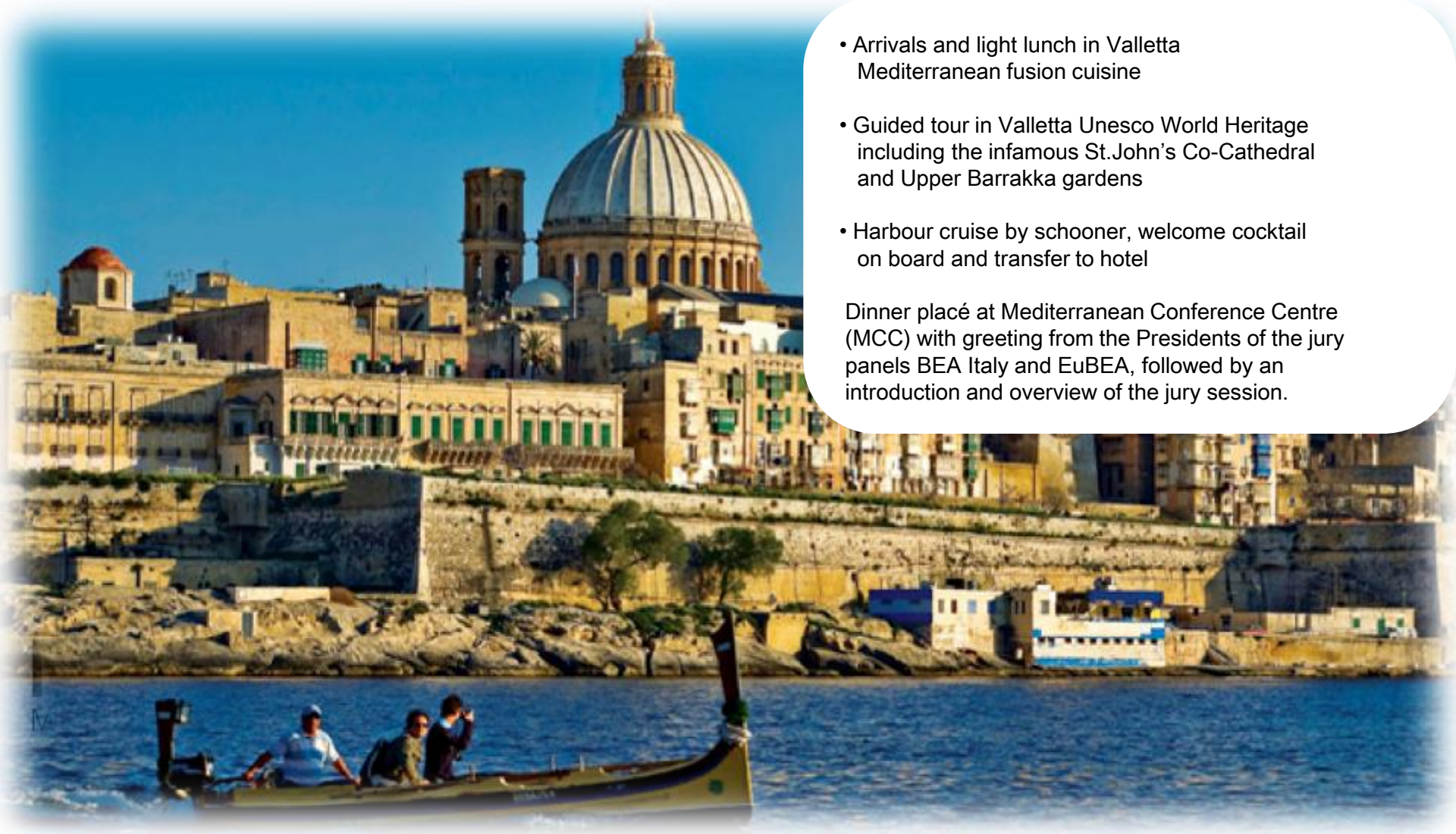




# DAY 1: Friday 11 of October 2013

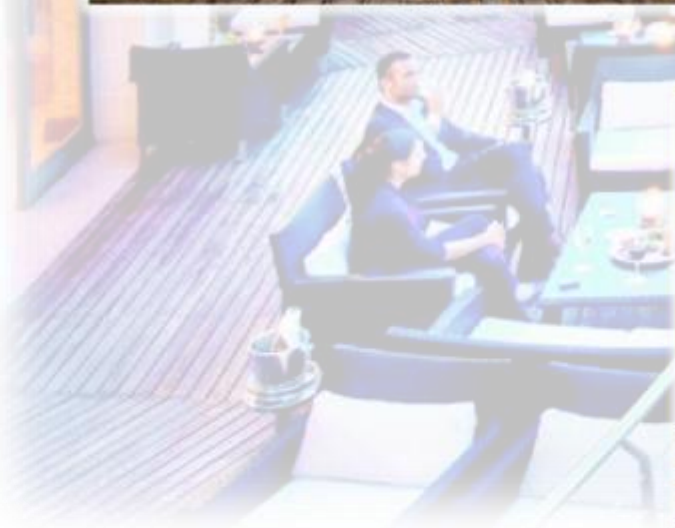

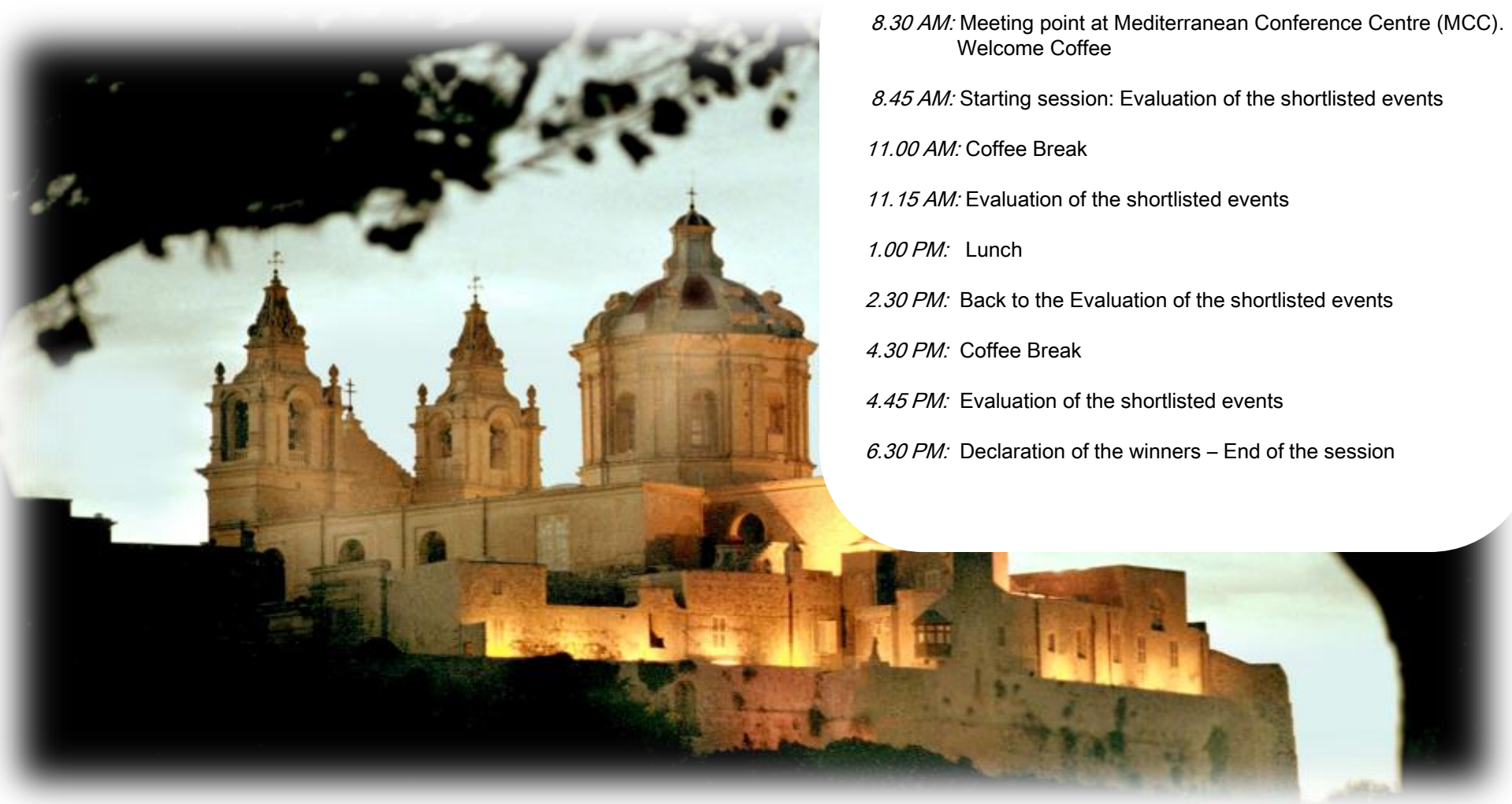
